CITY COUNCIL  
ELIGIBILITY/QUALIFICATIONS

Candidate Qualifications:

A candidate for City Council Must:

1. be a United States citizen;
2. be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election;
3. not have been determined by a final judgement of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be
4. Totally mentally incapacitated; or
5. Partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
6. not have been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
7. have resided continuously within the state of Texas for 12 months, and in the city of Daingerfield for the 6 months immediately preceding the deadline for filing an application for a place on the ballot;
8. be a registered voter in the territory from which the office is elected as of the date of the filing deadline for a candidate's place on the ballot
  - a. (for a write-in candidate, as of the date of the election).
9. shall not be indebted to the City such as property taxes, utility bills or municipal court tickets;
  - a. shall not hold any other public elective office of emolument,
  - b. and shall not be directly interested in the benefits or emoluments of any contract, job, work or service for the City, or interested in the sale to the City of any supplies, equipment, material or articles purchased where the amount of the purchase exceeds \$100.00;
  - c. nor shall either of them be the owner of one (1%) per cent of the outstanding stock in any public utility or public service corporation rendering service within the City
